Answer: Zacchaeus

Bible passage: Luke 19:1-10

When Jesus cast out demons from the demoniac (a man) what animal did Jesus cast the demons into?

Answer: Pigs

Bible passage: Mark 5:11-13

Answer: Judas

Bible passage: Luke 22:3-6

Bible passage: Matthew 28:18-20

Answers: feed the hungry, drink to the thirsty, welcome the stranger, clothes to the naked, care for the sick, visit those in prison, bury the dead

Bible passage: Mathew 25:34-36

Jesus said the kingdom of heaven is like this small seed

Answer: mustard seed

Bible passage: Matthew 17:20

When Jesus appears to two disciples on the road to Emmaus, how do they recognize him?

Answer: In the breaking of the bread

Bible passage: Luke 24:30-31

Jesus gives us the gift of the Eucharist during his last supper.

What do you remember about your first communion?

Bible passage: Luke 22:14-23

In the story of the Lost Sheep, Jesus teaches us that God loves us and will always seek us no matter how far we roam.

Share about a time when you felt far away from God. How did this feeling change?

Bible passage: Luke 15:4-7

In the Gospels Jesus teaches us that we all have a part to play in building the kingdom of God on earth.

What gifts and talents do you see in yourself? How could you use those gifts to build the kingdom of God?

Jesus named Peter to be the leader of the Church on earth.

If you were elected Pope, what changes would you make to the Church today? What would you keep the same?

Bible passage: Matthew 16:18

There are various stories in the Gospels where Jesus heals the blind.

What keeps you from seeing Jesus in your life?

Bible passage: Mark 8:22-25

Throughout the Gospels different people call Jesus different things (ex: Messiah, Son of God, friend, heretic, troublemaker).

Who do you say that Jesus is?

Bible passage: Mark 8:27-30

When Jesus calls his disciples they drop everything and follow him.

Are there parts of your life (habits, people) that you need to drop in order to follow Jesus more closely?

Bible passage: 1:16-20

Jesus meets a sick man who has no one to help him.

Who needs healing in your life? How can you use your gifts and talents to heal that person?

Bible passage: John 5:1-8

Jesus says that the sheep recognize the voice of the shepherd.

In the Gospels people give Jesus many different names.

What name would you want Jesus to call you by? (ex: sister, brother, friend, beloved disciple)

Bible passage: 10:1-6

How long did the Israelites walk in the desert?

Answer: Forty years

Bible Passage: Exodus 16: 35

What were the plagues of Egypt (name three at least)?

Answer: Frogs, locusts, blood water, gnats, flies, the boils, pestilence (livestock of the Egyptians died), hail, eternal darkness, death of the firstborn sons

Bible Passage: Exodus 7-11

What did Mordecai do to upset Haman in the story of Queen Esther?

Answer: He refused to bow before Haman

Bible Passage: Esther 3:1

Where did the Israelites go when they left Egypt?

Answer: the Red Sea
