---MISSION---

The Greeter Ministry serves the worshipping assembly by providing a welcoming, hospitable environment as the worshippers walk into our Church. They also support the unique character of the 5:30 Youth Mass by being teen and teen-family friendly.

---INTRODUCTION---

Greeters are an essential part of the hospitality of the 5:30 Youth Mass community as well as Holy Family Church. Your work requires skills in both anticipating and reacting to diverse situations. Teens and their adult helpers enhance our worship by welcoming everyone who comes into the church. Sometimes greeters will be asked to help pass out something before Mass begins.

Greeters are highly visible members of the 5:30 Youth Mass community. You must be dependable, hospitable, and gracious people. As with other liturgical leaders, you must commit to the highest standards of Christian living. Your dress must be respectful and appropriate for celebrating Mass.

---INSTRUCTIONS AND CODE OF CONDUCT---

Be responsible and arrive on time.

Meeting time is 5:15 pm. If you are scheduled and are not able to serve, please call another greeter to take your place.

Greeter arrives at the Fremont Doors at 5:15 pm and greets folks as they enter. They stay at their post until the beginning of the Liturgy of the Word. There will be reserved seating for greeters at Pew 30, or you may join your family wherever they might be seated. Greeters may not leave and go away from the church, it is expected that Greeters stay for all of Mass.

Essential Functions:

Arrive at least 15 minutes before services (dressed appropriately) and begin to ensure the cleanliness and safety of your assigned vestibule

Put away your cell phone

Pray together

Take your post with a smile

Welcome church attendees as they arrive, especially people who appear to be unfamiliar with Holy Family

Guide people with special needs to appropriate seating, generally in the area near the sanctuary on the tabernacle side of the church and when requested, pass out the Assisted Listen System

Stick around after Mass, and help the ushers put the church in good order, i.e. put worship books back into the holders, throw away trash and bulletins left in the pews

Possess knowledge of Holy Family Church's policies for handling medical emergencies, service disruptions, or church evacuations.

Sign and Observe the Guidelines as prescribed by the Archdiocese.

Behavior:

Come dressed appropriately to serve as a Liturgical Minister

Men, wear a collared shirt and your Greeter name badge

Ladies, a blouse or dress. If your blouse or dress does not have any kind of a sleeve, please kindly wear a sweater.

Nice pants (clean, neat and proper jeans are okay) or a skirt (no shorter than two inches above the knee). No short-shorts please.

No gum, food or drink in church

No cell phones

Please do not be a disturbance to the prayerful atmosphere; no goofing around

Be a full and active participant in the Mass
