Confirmation Session Make Up Veneration of the Cross

Read John 18:1-19:42, which was proclaimed at the Good Friday service and answer the following questions.

- If you could be one of the persons who witnessed Jesus' Passion, who would you be and why?
- If you could sum up the Passion into 5 words, what would they be?
- Find a picture from modern times that depicts what the Passion means to you and please explain why you chose it.

Example:

"This photo was taken after the earthquake in Japan in March 2011. There had been various stories about a mother



using her body as a shield to protect her child from the falling building.

Whether it is true or not, I don't doubt that a mother's love is strong
enough to move her to sacrifice her own life for her child's. When I see a
picture like this one, I am reminded about how strong God's love is for us
through Jesus' sacrifice. We hear it time and time again in church about
this sacrificial love but it become real when you see it personified in
today's world. We are to God what this child was to his mother. And
through all of the earth shaking events in our lives we can be reminded of
that life-giving love that was allotted to us through the Passion."

- John's gospel of the Passion differs from Matthew, Mark and Luke in how Jesus passes from this world. What do you think John means when he explains that Jesus "handed over the spirit" instead of "gave up his spirit" and "breathed his last"?



This phot was taken outside of Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland Flordia. Football coach Aaron Feis threw himself in front of students as bullets hailed at his alma mater. It would become perhaps the final act undertaken by the assistant coach and security guard, who suffered a gunshot wound and died after he was rushed into surgery. "He died the same way he lived -- he put himself second," a school official said. "He was a very kind soul, a very nice man. He died a hero." I am reminded of the words Jesus said, "There

is no greater love than to lay ones life for a friend."
