

Make up for Confirmation 1 Session 3

In this session, we discussed covenants. God has made covenants with his people throughout history. A covenant is an agreement by two parties that permanently impacts each person's identity, but it is not enforced by law. We discussed God's covenant with Abraham (Genesis 17:1-8) and Jonathan's covenant with David. This culminated in each group coming up with a group name and creating a covenant with one another.

- 1) How can you be a trusted member of the small group that you are a part of in Confirmation?
- 2) What qualities would you want in the group that you are a part of in Confirmation?
- 3) Explain one of the covenants God made with His people (other than Abraham). What was the covenant about? Who did he make it with? Is there a symbol associated with the covenant?
- 4) Now, think about someone in your life who you trust and you believe trusts you (someone outside of your household). Ask them the following questions and report back with their answers:
 - a. What qualities do you think make a trustworthy person?
 - b. Do you feel like you possess those qualities? Do you feel I possess those qualities?
 - c. Who would you consider the most trustworthy people in your life? Why?
